CANCELLATION OF TRAINING / MATCHES POLICY

TRAINING – SATURDAYS - 9.30-10.30 (WALLISDOWN REC)

Training will be cancelled for the following reasons:

- If Phoenix Youth FC Coaches deem the pitch to be unfit for play or dangerous
- If Phoenix Youth FC Coaches deem the weather conditions to be dangerous or add no value to the players development by training
- At the request of the Phoenix Youth FC Welfare Officer
- At the Phoenix Youth FC Secretary's discretion

In all cases Phoenix Youth FC Officials will put the players safety ahead of any decision to Train.

In all cases Phoenix Youth FC Officials will look to see if Training can be moved to an indoor venue or all-weather playing surface, dependant on availability and budget. You will be advised no later than 8.00 pm the preceding Friday via Whatsapp of any changes to venue or cancellation.

MATCHES – SUNDAYS – VARIOUS TIMES (FERNDOWN)

Matches will be cancelled for the following:

- If Phoenix Youth FC Coaches deem the pitch to be unfit for play or dangerous
- If Phoenix Youth FC Coaches deem the weather conditions to be dangerous or add no value to the players development by playing
- At the request of the Phoenix Youth FC Welfare Officer
- At the Phoenix Youth FC Secretary's discretion
- At the request of the Opposition Club Officials
- At the request of the Referee
- At the request of Dorset Football Association
- At the request of Ferndown Leisure Centre

In all cases Phoenix Youth FC Officials will put the players safety ahead of any decision to Play.

In all cases we will endeavour to replay any cancelled fixtures.

Unfortunately matches can be cancelled up to Kick Off or even during play, however we will use best efforts to advise you via Whatsapp of any cancellation.

In addition, if players do not bring the correct equipment to either training or matches (i.e. Shinpads, Water, Sun Cream – where necessary) or do not disclose any medical requirements, then unfortunately they will not be permitted to play.

In all the above cases the Secretary's decision is final.
